SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR MUSIC SECTIONS

Competitors, teachers and parents are strongly encouraged to make themselves familiar with all Launceston Competitions conditions and guidelines to ensure clarity in entries and Music rules.

A ENTRIES

- 1. It is the responsibility of entrants to ensure the information at the time of entry is correct. Any corrections necessary after entry closing date or the program is printed may incur an additional entry fee
- 2. Competitors may appear twice in any choral or vocal group class. In any instrumental group the competitor may appear twice, provided he or she plays a different instrument in the second performance, e.g. (a) piano, (b) flute.
- 3. In piano duet classes, a competitor may only appear twice with a different partner.
- 4. Where there are age groups provided for classes which are similar in nature, music competitors may compete in more than one class.
- 5. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or halve the prize money of any section that receives fewer than three entries.

B THEATRE RULES

- 6. All electrical items for use in the theatre and dressing rooms must be tagged by a certified electrician. This is the responsibility of each school or teacher and failure to comply will result in the appliance being confiscated.
- 7. A sound system is available for use at the Princess Theatre and Earl Arts Centre. Teachers and competitors are encouraged to check the sound systems well before they are required to ensure the correct devices are compatible with theatre equipment. Competitors are responsible for organizing an operator to play any backing tracks. There is no theatre technician or competition volunteer to do this.
- 8. No rehearsals will be permitted in the theatre during the week of the <u>Music sections</u>.
- 9. The lift backstage at the Princess Theatre cannot be operated during a session. Please ensure that any props, or equipment are at the theatre half an hour before the commencement time of the session involved. All props must be named. They must be removed from the stage area after use and not stored backstage.

C CHORAL WORK

- 10. The conductor of any choir may be a professional. Conductors must not sing with their choir.
- 11. Unless a special arrangement is made with the Committee at the time of entry, choirs must appear in the order listed in the program.

D INSTRUMENTAL WORK

- 12. Competitors note that time limits for instrumental items include setting up of instruments on stage. Time Limits will be strictly enforced. Failure to comply with time limits may result in a penalty.
- 13. Instrumental work may be accompanied.
- 14. Novice Classes are open to competitors who have never received a first prize in any instrumental solo in any competition at time of entry.

E PERFORMANCE RULES

- 14. Teachers and conductors must advise at the time of entry, the number of competitors in choirs and instrumental groups.
- 15. Schools must ensure that sufficient supervisory staff accompany their students to the theatre.
- 16. Competitors must provide a copy of their music for the use of the adjudicator along with the completed Form 1 and 2 found in this schedule. This must be in the hands of the Secretary by the commencement of the session. Failure to comply in this respect may disqualify the competitor. All bars must be numbered. Originals will be handed back to the competitor and photocopies will be destroyed.
- 17. In Own Selection classes no competitor shall be allowed to use the same piece with which he or she has won a first prize at a previous competition held by this Association.
- 18. Solo vocal competitors in music sections who hold music or manuscript, including those accompanying themselves, may not be assessed.
- 19. No prompting or assistance of any kind may be rendered to a competitor in any class during a performance. Any infringement of this may render the competitor liable to disqualification.
- 20. A vocal solo may only be accompanied by instruments, not other voices; for example, piano, guitar or non-vocal backing track.
- 21. Every care will be taken for the competitors' safety, but the Launceston Competitions Association will not be responsible for any injury sustained by a competitor during the competitions. Teachers and/or parents should be responsible for basic first aid equipment.
- 22. **Role of the Stage Manager.** Competitors, teachers, parents and others associated with competitions must obey the directions of the stage manager when in the area of the stage.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Entries

All entries must be completed through Stardom. **STARDOM.COM.AU** Entries will open on 1st February, 2024 and close on 22nd March, 2024. **No late entries will be accepted**.

Please ensure that all entry information is correct. Any corrections necessary after the programme is printed, which are due to an entrant's failure to supply correct information, may incur an additional entry fee.

Copies of all schedules are available on the Association's website (launcestoncompetitions.org).

Professional performers may enter as Open competitors only.

A competitor's age shall be reckoned as at 1st January. If requested, competitors must be prepared to produce a Birth Certificate. Teachers may notify the Secretary of any student requiring special consideration in order to perform.

Please note that in 2024 exact numbers performing in group sections need to be advised at time of entry.

2. Programme

The programme will indicate the order in which competitors are to perform. Changes will only be made if permission has been sought from the Stage Manager or Secretary before the respective section begins.

Competitors may be disqualified if they are not present when called upon to perform. The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the programme at any time.

3. Adjudication

In all classes, prizes will be awarded according to the decision of the Adjudicator, who may not necessarily award any placings in a given section.

Aggregate awards are decided on a point sum basis: first 7, second 5, third 3, HC 1.

No discussion should be entered into at any time with the adjudicator.

All decisions of the adjudicator must be accepted as final subject to the following:

(a) Protests in any class must be in writing, signed and lodged with the Secretary within 2 hours of the Adjudicator's decision together with a deposit of \$20.

(b) The Committee shall appoint three of its number to a panel of appeal which shall hear any protests as soon as practicable after receipt by the Secretary.

(c) The deposit shall be forfeited if the appeal is unsuccessful.

4. Performances

A competitor must not use the same item more than once during the current season of the competitions.

No competitor may use an item with which he or she has previously been awarded a first prize in any class of the Launceston Competitions for more than two consecutive years.

The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any competitor whose item is deemed unsuitable.

No competitor shall address the audience from the platform either during any session excepting where such address is intrinsic to the performance. Any competitor violating this condition will be liable to disqualification and forfeiture of prizes.

Time Limits will be strictly applied. Failure to comply with time limits may result in a penalty.

Every care will be taken for the competitors' safety, but the Launceston Competitions Association will not be responsible for any injury sustained by a competitor during the competitions. Teachers and/or parents should be responsible for basic first aid equipment.

No performance is to be videoed, photographed, recorded or uploaded to social media.

5. Theatre Rules

Due to fire regulations, teachers are advised that the use of straw or bales of hay are not permitted. **Naked flames are not permitted on stage**; this includes candles.

The committee will not be responsible for music or stage property not claimed on the day of performance unless owners have permission from the Stage Manager to leave these in the theatre.

The lift backstage at the Princess Theatre cannot be operated during a session. Please ensure that any props, music stands or equipment are at the theatre half an hour before the commencement time of the session involved. All props must be named. They must be removed from the stage area after use and not stored backstage.

No food items or liquids are allowed on stage.

All electrical items for use in the theatre and dressing rooms must be tagged by a certified electrician. This is the responsibility of each school or teacher and failure to comply will result in the appliance being confiscated.

A sound system is available for use at the Princess Theatre and Earl Arts Centre. Teachers and competitors are encouraged to check the sound systems well before they are required to ensure the correct devices are compatible with theatre equipment. Competitors are responsible for organizing an operator to play any backing tracks. There is no theatre technician or competition volunteer to do this.

6. Copyright Bylaw

Entrants may perform only from original or licensed copies from publishers. Adjudicator's and accompanist's copies may be photocopies. The Adjudicator's copy will be destroyed after the performance. Competitors are responsible for royalty payments if necessary. The Association will take no responsibility for copyright infringements by entrants.

The decision of the Committee in all questions and disputes arising out of, or not provided for, by these conditions shall be final. All entries received are subject to this provision and will not be subject to any appeal at law.
